Ensure accuracy in what items are picked and quantities. • Pack customer orders for shipment. Choose lowest cost mode of transportation and package in boxes or palletize to ensure the quality of the order is maintained through shipment. Use handheld scanner to verify correct product is shipped. Ensure accurate quantities and perform general inspection of tools during process. Enter shipment info into shipping software and manufacturing software to process orders. • Load small parcel trailers with packages. Quote LTL freight to determine lowest cost preferred carrier and schedule shipment. Enter freight dimensions and order info into manufacturing software to process orders. Run end of day processes in shipping software and manufacturing software to close out shipments. • Replenish packaging material and re-label product as needed to fulfill sales orders. Cycle count inventory and enter corrections to inventory into manufacturing software, issue necessary shipping supplies to department. Clean, re-arrange department, and make process/department improvements. Qualifications High school diploma or GED. Three months related experience. Standing/walking 95+ percent of the time on a hard surface. Occasional lifting of 25-50 lbs./Frequent lifting of 10-24 lbs.
